Susanna Carolusson, licensed psychologist, obtained her M.Sc. in psychology from Gothenburg University, Sweden, in 1984. She is Director of advanced teaching programs for the Swedish Society of Clinical Hypnosis (SSCH), a former editor of the Swedish Journal of Hypnosis, and former chairperson for the Milton Erickson Foundation for Science and Research (SSCH). She has lectured and consulted internationally, including Russia and Poland, where she has established advanced programs in clinical hypnosis and Ego State Therapy respectively. She has presented at over forty congresses in Europe, Africa, and North America, and authored or co-authored seven books and over thirty scholarly papers. Workshop Summary:

Clinical psychologist Susanna Carolusson has used hypnosis as an adjunct in therapy since her training 40 years ago. In this workshop she will share and demonstrate how she combines hypnotic techniques and approaches, which often are regarded as separate and mutually different: Psychodynamic Ego State therapy and Ericksonian approaches.

Although independent of each other and with separate congregations for collegial educations, research and development, the psychodynamic, hypnotic egostate and Ericksonian traditions share a basic belief in the power of unconscious powerful dynamics: defense mechanisms, trauma-caused dissociation, transference reactions, unconscious resources and creative ways to reach resources for healing. In lectures, demonstrations and exercises, Susanna aims to illustrate why and how Ego State therapy is close to Ericksonian values of respect for the unique client's resources for healing and also how transference work can add to explorative and integrative egostate work. Various deeply diagnostic, uncovering and resource-building techniques, e.g. Shorr's "Finish the Sentence", will be shared. Susanna fathoms the idea that you can pick the best from various experts in your field and combine them in a, for you, genuine way, and thus create a unique healing relation to each client. A case consultation will also be done in that format of a role play.

10:00-10:45	Demonstration of the integrated perspective: Case consultation by role play with volunteer from the audience.

11:00-12:00	Demonstration of Ego State Therapy with Ericksonian style. Discussion of techniques, such as "utilizing", "pace-leading" and "implications. Discussion of techniques observed during the demonstration.

1:00-2:00	When Ego State Therapy is "my safe-line": Ego State Therapy as a map and technique. Case illustration: Dissociative Identity Disorder. Each Ego state forms its own relationship with the therapist. Integration through the development of relations in therapy.
2:00-3:00	Practice in dyads/triads. Choose a simple personal conflict, ambivalence or bad habit. Use ego states to represent the symptomatic part versus the ideal part. Interview these two or ego states. Accept symptoms as functional. Explore and utilize, following and leading, by pacing and implicating. Give each other feedback. Did the "therapist" apply utilizing, pace-leading and implication? Reverse roles

3:15-3:30	Whole group discussion on learnings from small group practice.
3:30-4:15	Demonstration of Ego State work by Susanna, based on what a volunteer client reports from the exercise before break.
4:15-4:45	Group hypnosis, followed by discussion in dyads/triads, ensuring a safe and constructive closure of the hypnosis.
4:45-5:00	Question and Answer.

4:30-4:45	Question and Answer and Wrap-Up in creative adieu.
4:45-5:00	Workshop evaluations.

Discussion, small group practice, and Q & A will play a prominent role in the program: a minimum of 25% of workshop time will be allotted to interaction.

Eligibility

Applicants for training at any CSCH-OD workshop must be regulated by a College under the RHPA or the OCSWSSW (or their equivalents in other provinces or states) and they must have at least a Master's degree.
